This is to request your help in determining if my husband has any relatives presently living in the Apeldoorn area, and, if possible, to learn more about his grandfather's early childhood.

My husband and I are planning a trip to the Netherlands in 1993. All of his grandparents are from the Netherlands, and he grew up speaking Dutch. As part of our trip, we would like to visit some of the areas that his ancestors came from, and, if possible, visit relatives.

Following is the information that my husband vaguely remembers from one of his grandfathers, and as much as we were able to learn from the archives at the University of Wisconsin-Madison.

named - Aalt Pieters - changed to Alt Peters and Allen Peters when he came to the United States.

born - April 27, 1864

parents - Johann Pieters
Gertje Brounhost Pieters

Came to the United States in 1881 at the age of 17 with two of his brothers--one was named Camille (sp?). (We believe that a sister stayed in the Netherlands.) *Kneil*

His Grandfather has told him of living in Apeldoorn and of working as a gardener at the summer residence of royalty. (We are not sure if his Grandfather or if it was his Great Grandfather Johann Pieters that was the gardener.)

We would appreciate any information you can give us on names and addresses of relatives and/or background on Aalt Pieters and his ancestors.

Dear Mrs. Hagen,

In order to your letter we have done inquiry to the family Peeters who lived in the villages Hoog Soeren and Het Loo during the nineteenth century. The sources were the registers of birth, marriage and death and the parishregisters of the township of Apeldoorn. The results are as followed.

- I. Lammert Peters, born august 27, 1802 to Apeldoorn, son of Gerrit Peters and Cornelia Cornelissen, died march 19, 1856 to Apeldoorn. He married december 9, 1825 to Apeldoorn with Jannetje van Kampen, born june, 3 1808 to Apeldoorn, daughter of Andries Johannessen and Anna Willems. Later (after 1825) she became the name Van Kampen.
They lived in the village Hoog Soeren, wich belonged to Apeldoorn.
- II. Their son Johannes Peters was born march 11, 1829 to Apeldoorn in the village Hoog Soeren.
He was a labourer. He married september 2, 1853 to Apeldoorn with Geertje Bronkhorst, born march 12, 1833 to Apeldoorn in the village Uddel. Until 1856 and 1859 they moved to the village Het Loo where also the palace Het Loo is situated. There he became a servant of king William III.
Their children were:
 1. Lambert, born february 26, 1854 to Hoog Soeren (fol. III.1)
 2. Jan, born november 13, 1856 to Hoog Soeren (fol. III.2)
 3. Jannetje, born july 9, 1859 to Het Loo (fol. III.3)
 4. Gerrit, born july 25, 1862 to Het Loo
 5. Aalt, born april 28, 1864 to Het Loo
 6. Johannes, born february 27, 1866 to Het Loo
 7. Andries Juliaan, january 19, 1868 to Het Loo
 8. Gijs, born july 28, 1870 to Het Loo
 9. Hendrik Jan, born february 27, 1873 to Het Loo
 10. Cornelis Hendrikus, born december 6, 1875 to Het LooJohannes Peters and Geertje Bronkhorst departed in august 1881 to the United States of America with their children Gerrit, Aalt, Johannes, Andries Juliaan or Johan, Gijs, Hendrik Jan and Cornelis Hendrikus.

III.1. Lammert Peters, born february 26, 1854 to Hoog Soeren was housepainter and shopkeeper, later postman in the village Wenum. He lived with his family on the Oude Zwolseweg. He was married on may 23, 1874 to Apeldoorn with Hendrika Hulleman, born october 27, 1851 to Apeldoorn. She was a daughter of Geurt Hulleman en Aartje Strijk.

Their children were:

1. Johannes Lambertus, born march 6, 1875 to Apeldoorn
2. Gerrit, born march 31, 1877 to Apeldoorn
3. Arend, born february 11, 1878 to Apeldoorn, died june 9, 1878
4. Gerard, born october 10, 1879 to Apeldoorn
5. Aartje, born october 20, 1881 to Apeldoorn, died october 24, 1883 to Apeldoorn
6. Frederika Johanna, born september 4, 1883 to Apeldoorn
7. Lammert, born october 31, 1886 to Apeldoorn
8. Hendrik, born september 15, 1888 to Apeldoorn
9. Aart, born september 3, 1891 to Apeldoorn

This family departed on august 2, 1894 to the United States of America.

III.2. Jan Peters, born november 13, 1856 to Apeldoorn, was a carpenter. He married on may 1, 1879 to Apeldoorn with Wilhelmina Jonkers, born april 1, 1860 to Apeldoorn. She was a daughter of Hendrik Jonker and Willemina IJzerman. They lived on Reeënlaan 35 to Apeldoorn and departed february 17, 1916 to Laren in the province North-Holland.

Their children were:

1. Johannes Gerrit, born february 8, 1880 to Apeldoorn.
He was a blacksmith and departed on march 24, 1902 to Woerden.
2. Hendrik Willem, born february 2, 1882 to Apeldoorn.
He was a paperer and departed on february 2, 1902 to Hengelo in the province Overijssel.
3. Jan Willem, born november 27, 1890 to Apeldoorn.
He was a carpenter and departed on january 4, 1910 to Rotterdam.

III.3. Jannetje Peters, born july 9, 1859 to Apeldoorn. She had a child Johann Gerard, born july 10, 1878 who died june 5, 1879 to Apeldoorn. She married july 12, 1879 to Apeldoorn with Willem van Loenen, born september 8, 1853 to Apeldoorn. He was a son of Gerrit van Loenen, labourer, and Hendrika Johanna Hoegen.

Their children were:

1. Geurt, born april 19, 1880 to Apeldoorn
2. Geertje, born january 5, 1882 to Apeldoorn
3. Hendrikus Johannes, born october 26, 1883 to Apeldoorn, died october 20, 1884 to Apeldoorn
4. Jannetje, born march 15, 1885 to Apeldoorn
5. Hendrika Johanna, born april 4, 1886 to Apeldoorn

This family departed august 17, 1886 to the United States of America.

So as you can see from this information there are no direct relatives of the family Peters in Apeldoorn. One son and three grandchildren stayed in the Netherlands.
